Audits. Inspections. Incidents. That's when confidence is tested, not by intention, but by proof.



Compliance is judged on evidence, not intention.



The problem with assumed compliance

Compliance rarely fails because people ignore their responsibilities. It fails because:

- Checks are assumed to have happened
- Records are completed later
- Activity is summarised, not verified
- Evidence is scattered across systems and teams


On paper, everything looks fine. Under scrutiny, gaps start to appear. And when compliance depends on explanation rather than evidence, the conversation quickly becomes uncomfortable.

Audits don't test effort. They test evidence.

Auditors don't assess how hard teams work. They assess what can be proven. They ask simple questions:

- ! Did the check actually happen?
- ! Was someone physically present?
- ! Did it happen when it was required?
- ! Can this still be proven months or years later?


Without clear, verifiable evidence, even well-run operations can struggle to defend themselves.



Why Proof of Compliance makes a difference

Teams complete inspections on the spot, with guidance, documents, and questions available directly from the tag, even without signal or Wi-Fi.

Once connectivity returns, the system syncs securely and automatically.

Compliance happens in the moment, or not at all.

How it works (in plain English)

Each compliance-critical asset, from fire alarms and fire doors to washrooms and safety equipment, is fitted with a unclonable Trusted NFC tag.

To complete a check, a team member must be physically present and tap the tag. That single action:

- Verifies location and timing
- Identifies who completed the check
- Triggers a structured checklist immediately

What is Trusted NFC?

On tapping, a unique, encrypted URL is activated verifying the tag and location with a timestamp.



Why this proof stands up in high-scrutiny environments

Proof of Compliance removes the weaknesses that audits expose.

- Checks can't be completed remotely
- Records can't be back-filled later
- Missed activity can't be hidden in reports
- Evidence can't be altered after the fact

Every interaction is time-stamped, asset-specific, and stored permanently. Instead of relying on "someone said it was done", Proof of Compliance shows exactly what happened, where, and when.
